

PINECONES

This page is to help you understand the order form when choosing pinecones and also for you to see what cones we have available.

BASIC	In most cases we will use ponderosa pinecones, except extra large or smaller items. The large items such as 30" wreaths and larger we use larger cones such as slash pine, large ponderosa, or Jeffery pine. For smaller items such as 12 inch wreaths we use scotch pine, red pine, firs or spruce. Standard for 18"-24" wreaths is 3 cones. For 30" we use 4 cones, and for 36" we use 5 cones. The larger size wreaths most times look better with larger cones or extra cones or the cones will look lost in the wreath. So if you choose basic on the order form, we will do what we standardly think looks best for the wreath or other item.
Mixed	Mixed pine cones means we will mix up the types to give a more unique look to your item.
Extra	Extra means we will add extra pinecones to your item, usually adding a mix of a smaller and larger cone, or two different types, whichever looks best.
Small	Means we will only use smaller cones on your item.
Large	Means we will only use larger cones on your item.
Gold	Means we will only use gold painted cones on your item. We only have medium sized cones, so we don't recommend them for larger items.
White-tipped	Means we will only use white tipped cones on your item. We only have medium sized cones, so we don't recommend them for larger items.

Norway Spruce	A fairly large cone that can be used on larger wreaths and mixed with other cones for extra texture. Approximately 4 - 5", light brown.		\$0.39 each
Eastern White Pine	Approximately 3 - 5" light to medium brown (petals are commonly tipped with white dried sap)		\$0.39 each
Western White Pine	Approximately 5 - 7" +, blonde to medium brown		\$0.99
Sugar Pine	HUGE Cones. Great for decorating! Medium brown 10-15" long!		\$5.99
Sitka Spruce	Pale creamy-brown cones; Papery petals have a crinkly, toothed edge. Approx. 2-3"		\$0.39 each



Englemann Spruce	Approximately 1 - 3" blonde to light brown (Limited quantities)	\$0.39 each
Western Larch (Tamarack)	Small cone approx 3/4 - 2", light brown to dark reddish brown (Limited quantities)	\$0.39 each
White Tipped Pinecones	Pine 2-3" tipped in white paint resembling snow tipped cones. Brightens up greenery. (Limited Supply)	\$0.99
