This group benefits from a regular fungicide regiment and need their canes mulched heavily to survive our winters unless otherwise indicated.

Fungicides are not needed for this group if they are under good culture and spacing. Miniature roses are hardy as well although they tend to be prone to blackspot due to their dense habit.

Groundcover and Tree Roses

Groundcover roses spread wider than tall, often rooting where they touch the ground. The blooms are smaller than most roses, although they recur in large clusters throughout the season. Groundcover roses require no special winter protection, although for best appearance they need cut down 4-6" after winter before growth resumes in the spring. Fungicides are not needed for this group if they are under good culture. Tree roses need special winter protection, either by moving containerized plants to a sheltered area or by severing half of the roots, lying down horizontally and then mulching heavily.
